Weimaraner Breed Appreciation Day

The Breed Appreciation Day (BAD) is open to all who wish to gain a better understanding of the Weimaraner. The BAD is a mandatory requirement for all judges wishing to progress from Level 1 to Level 2 on the Judges Competency Framework (JCF). The Kennel Club has stated that from 2020, all judges will need to be registered on at least JCF Level 1 in order to undertake any judging appointment.

The morning session will consist of an in-depth introduction to the Weimaraner and the Kennel Club Breed Standard, which is an essential part of the criteria for awarding CC's in the breed followed by a Multiple Choice Exam (MCE).

Following lunch there will be an opportunity for a limited number of candidates (12) to take part in a group mentoring session. Successful candidates in this will count towards progression to JCF Level 3. Candidates must have passed the MCE in the morning to be eligible to take part in the mentoring session.

Anyone can attend the BAD but only judges that have undertaken the following Kennel Club education seminars are eligible to take the Multiple Choice Exam.

- To have passed the Rules & Regulations of a Dog Show Judge
- To have passed the Points of the Dog Assessment
- To have attended a Conformation & Movement seminar
- To have completed 6 days stewarding
