The Breed Appreciation Day (BAD) is open to all who wish to gain a better understanding of the Weimaraner. The BAD and MCE are a mandatory requirement for all judges wishing to progress from Level 1 to Level 2 on the Judges Education Programme (JEP). The Kennel Club has stated that from 2021, all judges will need to meet all the requirements of JEP Level 1 in order to undertake any judging appointment.

The morning session will consist of an in-depth introduction to the Weimaraner and the Kennel Club Breed Standard, which is an essential part of the criteria for awarding CC's in the breed followed by a Multiple Choice Exam (MCE).

Following lunch, there will be an opportunity for a limited number of candidates to take part in the A3 hands-on assessment for those judges using the current system.

Anyone can attend the BAD but only judges that currently meet JEP Level 1 are eligible to take the Multiple Choice Exam. The requirements to meet JEP Level 1 are:

- Minimum of five years proven interest in pedigree dogs
- Attend a Requirements of a Dog Show Judge seminar (but not mandatory to take and pass examination)
- Attend a Conformation and Movement seminar
- Complete a minimum of two full-day stewarding appointments
